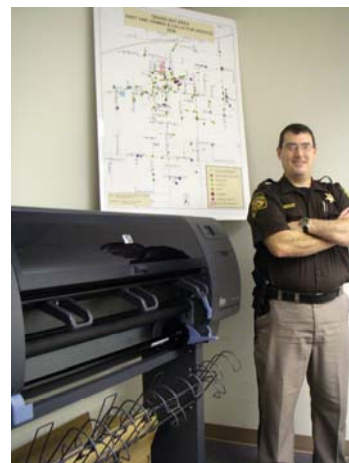
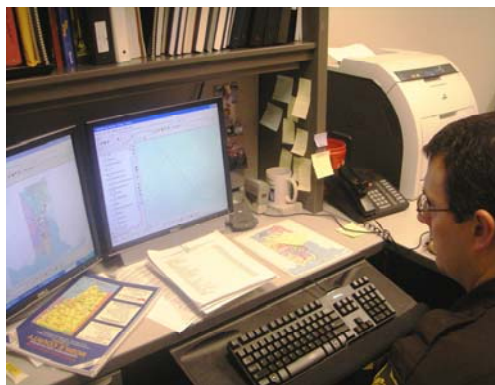




# Mobile County Sheriff's Office

The Sheriff's Office has recently hired Crime Analyst Deputy Jason Lindsay to its staff. With over five years of experience in law enforcement, three years have been spent mapping crime in Mobile. A typical day for Lindsay requires studying nearly 100 case reports from patrol units. Lindsay analyzes the data and when a pattern is detected the information is plotted out on a map. With this information, the Sheriff's Office can be more efficient in its crime-fighting tactics. From increasing patrols around such locations, to analyzing the overall increase or decrease of crime in certain areas, the Sheriff's Office can see its efforts working, first-hand.

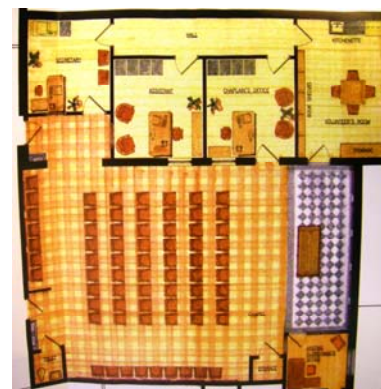
